RESIDENCY DURATION: 12 MONTHS (APRIL 2026 – APRIL 2027)

RESIDENCY INCLUDES:

- 24-hour shared studio access
- basic supplies (newsprint, cleaners) : Note: some print making materials are not included (paper, coating, certain inks) For this residency, artists bring these or purchase them locally.
- storage space
- one free class in printmaking and consultations with Master Printers
- weekly individual meetings with our staff for research assistance, project guidance, and critiques. Note: Technical assistance is not included in the program, but is available at additional cost.
- 20% discount on all Printshop classes
- free digital documentation of selected works produced during the residency
- inclusion in the Printshop's permanent collection
- opportunity to show and sell new work during a final show after the residency has ended. All works are sold unframed. Sales tax, shipping, and handling charges will be added to the artwork prices.
- The residency is a studio residency and does not include travel expenses, living and housing.
- You may apply for subsidy at state governed bodies.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicants must be 40 or older.
- Applicants must have a final degree.
- German or English language skills are required.
